WORRIED about business check fraud?

Positive Pay automatically verifies incoming checks against a file that contains a detailed listing of

issued check information and identifies any mismatched items as they are presented. This automation ensures only outstanding checks on file clear your account thereby protecting you account against forged, altered, and counterfeit checks.

The check information submitted in the file includes check number, dollar amount, date issued, and payee name. If the information for any of the checks does not match the file, the bank notifies you through an exception item report and withholds payment until you decide to accept or reject the item.

Positive Pay allows you the flexibility to upload files multiple times a day. It maintains an audit trail of all your transmissions. It offers you the means to efficiently and securely manage your funds. Most importantly, it keeps you in control of your account!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT OPENING A LEGAL ENTITY ACCOUNT

(BENEFICIAL OWNERSHIP)

Effective May 11, 2018, new rules under the Bank Secrecy Act will aid the government in the fight against crimes to evade financial measures designed to combat terrorism and other national security threats.

EACH time an account is opened for a covered Legal Entity, we are required to ask you for identifying information (name, address, date of birth, social security number as well as identification documents) for:

- Each individual that has beneficial ownership (25% or more); and,
- One individual that has significant managerial control, of the Legal Entity.

If you are opening an account on behalf of a Legal Entity, you will be required to provide the appropriate documentation and to certify that this information is true and accurate to the best of your knowledge.
